

Art Year 2 - Sculpture



INTENT

This unit of work links to the children science unit 'Life and Life Cycles'. The children will use clay to create their own sculpture inspired from the work of Barbara Hepworth and her use of sculptures to frame the landscape and to make you look at things differently. There will be an emphasis on shape and form of materials and opportunity for children to use line and shape to decorate their final piece.
