INTENT

Linking to the history unit 'Ancient Greece', the children will have lots of opportunity to observe different sources from this time to explore and sketch Greek patterns. They can experiment with different pencils to create texture and produce increasingly accurate drawings of people when designing their own Greek inspired pot.
