INTENT

Linking to the children's history work on 'Our Town Through Time - Significant Local History', the children will study the work of artist L.S Lowry to explore the use of tools and texture particularly when observing and drawing the human anatomy. They will then apply these skills to re-create their own Lowry inspired observational drawing of a scene of Shrewsbury.
