INTENT

We will identify the key features of persuasive writing by analysing effective examples and use these to create a persuasive letter based on our reading of Krindlekrax in Guided reading.

<u>When writing we are going to:</u> Plan our writing: • By identifying the audience and purpose of the writing. • By using other writing as a model for structure and language in a persuasive piece of writing. • By noting and developing initial ideas, drawing on reading and research with support. Draft and write: • By using a range of devices to build cohesion within and across paragraphs. • Selecting appropriate grammar and vocabulary, in order to write persuasively. Evaluate and edit: • By proposing changes to vocabulary, grammar and punctuation to clarify meaning. • By ensuring the correct subject and verb agreement. • By ensuring the consistent and correct use of tenses.
