

Change the Story - Toys through Time.

During this unit, we will explore what toys looked like in the past, what they look like now and what we'd like the toys of the future to look like.



These are the key skills and knowledge you will gain through this unit:

Knowledge	<u>Invading and Settling</u> I can recognise that toys are made in different places. <u>Social History</u> I can name and identify toys from then and now. I can describe toys from then and now exploring similarities and differences. <u>Technological Development</u> I can say how toys today show technological advances compared to toys from the past.
Skills	<u>Similarity and Difference</u> I can identify similarities and difference between things in the past and now. <u>Cause and Consequence</u> I can give reasons for how things are different and begin to understand why (e.g. new materials, electricity). <u>Exploring Sources</u> I can comment on artefacts from the past.
