Knowledge	<u>Geographical Knowledge</u> I know how Hinduism is practised around the world. <u>Historical Knowledge</u> I know where the Hindu faith began. <u>Religious Knowledge</u> I know some of the symbols and actions of the Hindu faith.
Skills	The skill focus of this unit is on developing our speaking, listening and presentation skills: I can use role-play and other drama techniques to identify with and explore stories. I can use language I've learnt in role play to retell a narrative.
