Y6 Residential Trip 02 – 05 September 2025

Dear Parents/Carers

When children reach year 6 we arrange a residential trip for them in the autumn term. This year is no exception, and we are sure the children will be looking forward to it.

We would like to invite you to attend a meeting to find out all about the trip, on Tuesday 4th February at 2.40pm in school.

The final price of the visit is confirmed as **£335** per child. This includes return coach travel, full board (from Tuesday's evening meal, a packed lunch will need to be provided on the travel day, Tuesday) all equipment use, including waterproof jacket, waterproof trousers, walking boots and all safety equipment. The centre is staffed by highly trained instructors and members of school staff also accompany the children ensuring appropriate ratios.

We would therefore ask for a **£60** deposit to secure your child's place and will put the full amount of the trip onto ParentPay which you can reduce in instalments. **We would ask for the deposit by Friday 28th February 2025** to confirm your child's place. We have put together a table of payments for your convenience, however you may pay whenever it suits you. **The full cost should be paid by Friday 25th July 2025.**
