These rules help us to stay safe on the Internet:

- We only use the internet when an adult is with us.
- We can click on the buttons or links when we know what they do.
- We can search the Internet with an adult.
- We always ask if we get lost on the Internet.
- We can write polite and friendly emails to people that we know.

Key Stage Two - Pupil Acceptable Use Policy

Think then Click

We expect all pupils to be responsible for their own behaviour on the Internet, just as they are anywhere else in school. This includes materials they choose to access and language they choose to use.

- We ask permission before using the Internet.
- We only use websites approved by an adult.
- We tell an adult if we see anything we are uncomfortable with.
- We immediately turn off the screen if we not sure about a website.
- We send e-mails that are polite and friendly.
- We never give out personal information or passwords.
- We never arrange to meet anyone we don't know.
- We do not open e-mails sent by anyone we don't know.
- We do not use Internet chat rooms.
- We do not download anything.
- We ask before printing anything out.
