Catch Up Premium Plan 2020-21

All schools have been allocated money to provide catch up for the time missed due to the result of COVID. The allocated money is calculated on a per pupil basis, with a total of £80 for each pupil in years reception through to year 6. The BEC Federation Schools have the authority to decide how best this money should be spent thinking about the greatest impact for the children. This will fall under the following sections: Section 1 – Teaching, Section 2 - Targeted Academic Support or Section 3 - Wider Strategies. At the end of each term we will identify the impact of these strategies and make any necessary changes for the following term.

Spring

During the Spring Term the BEC Federation of schools has decided to focus on projects that will address some of the wider strategies identified in the SDP and education areas identified during the third Lockdown. For example, we have invested in the Read Write Inc scheme to refresh the scheme at St Patrick's and to relaunch at SCCPS and N.

Autumn Term 2

During the Autumn Term (Autumn 2) the BEC Federation of schools has decided to focus on Targeted Academic Support for years 1-6 and wider strategies for the reception cohort. The Targeted Academic Support will be delivered by the class teachers on two afternoons after school. The focus for one session will be Maths and the other Reading comprehension strategies. Both schools conducted baseline assessments in October to identify attainment, progress and most importantly the children the class teachers felt needed the first round of catch up based on the data and observations.
