At Shrewsbury Cathedral Catholic Primary School and Nursey, we are using our funding to enhance PE and Sport via investment in:

- Using a Sports Coach to deliver high quality coaching sessions and to work alongside our class teachers to support the teaching of high-quality PE.
- Continuing our Partnership with our local schools to ensure children have the opportunity to take part in inter school competitions regularly.
- Maintaining and developing high quality resources to support and enhance the PE curriculum.
- Maintaining and developing high quality resources to support and enhance the outside provision at playtime and lunchtime.
- To raise the profile of participation in different sports from identified groups.
- Continue to ensure that transport to sporting events is covered and that these costs does not prohibit participation.
