Dear Parents and Carers,

At this time each year, we write on behalf of the Bishop to invite voluntary contributions to the Diocesan School Building Fund.

At Shrewsbury Cathedral Catholic Primary School and Nursery we are continually working to improve our facilities—often in ways that may not be immediately visible. Recent projects are I.T. equipment replacement, EYFS area improvements and replacement windows.

While Our Lady Help of Christians Multi Academy Trust generously covers the majority of these costs, as a voluntary aided school, we are required to contribute a portion ourselves. In return for the privilege of promoting the Catholic faith in our schools, 90% of the cost of building works and major repairs is funded by the Trust. The remaining 10% is supported by the Diocese—through the Schools Building Fund.

This year, our school's contribution is £970. We understand that many families are facing financial pressures due to the rising cost of living. However, we would be deeply grateful if each family could consider making a voluntary donation of £5 per child. Every contribution helps ensure that more of our school's budget can be directed toward enriching your child's education.

To make giving easier, donations can now be made securely via ARBOR. All contributions are recorded confidentially.

We are sincerely thankful to all families who have supported the fund in previous years—your generosity has made a real difference. We now humbly ask for your continued support to help us maintain and improve our school environment for all our children.
